

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE OF CHANGES IN HOW YOUR ACCOUNT INFORMATION WITH AP&T MAY BE ACCESSED**

The FCC has enacted rules aimed at providing consumers with greater privacy of their telephone call records.

This information is referred to as "**Customer Proprietary Network Information**", or CPNI.

The types of information covered under the changes include but are not limited to, phone numbers called by a consumer, the frequency and duration, as well as the timing of such calls. Also affected by the scope of these changes is statement information and the services or features associated with an account, such as Call Waiting etc.

FCC Regulations instruct telephone carriers how and under what circumstances account information can be provided to a requesting party. The intent is to protect consumers against unauthorized persons gaining access to personal customer billing information.

AP&T has posted our CPNI Privacy Policy on our website along with Frequently Asked Questions about how these changes may affect your interaction with customer representatives when requesting information about your personal account with us.
