Qualifications:

- Must be familiar with hydraulic systems and electrical systems and be able to read / understand hydraulic and electrical automotive schematics
- Must be familiar with computer engine diagnostics
- Previous heavy equipment operating experience is required
- Ability to operate track backhoes and other heavy equipment
- Must possess the ability to weld
- Must have air brake experience, and/or certification, and the ability to perform inspections
- Must possess the ability to perform annual DOT inspections
- Ability to obtain flagger certification within 1 month of hire date
- Must be personally equipped with own mechanic tools
- Basic or advanced computer skills is a must
- A familiarity with computer based Maintenance Program is required
- A US Passport is required for occasional travel through Canada
