



Junior Telecom OSP Engineer

They will possess excellent team and interpersonal skills, and the ability to work with little to no supervision.

The general purpose of this job is to design and maintain digital mapping facilities and supporting systems. The Junior Telecom OSP Engineer reports to the GM of Telecom Operations – North.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform detailed work on outside plant work orders as prescribed by customer requirements or internal project plans
- Design the placement, rearrangement, or removal of telecommunication facilities
- Make field trips and interact with customers, developers, and municipalities.
- Prepare electronic drawings using NISC MapWise Mapping system.
- Compile data required for the preparation of plans or work order drawings.
- Assist in the procurement of materials for work orders
- Perform statewide field visits; meet with developers, customers, local agencies
- Secure the necessary field information, record verifications, and document preparation required to prepare work order construction prints.
- Update maps based on as-built drawings received from the field
- Assist with maintenance of Facilities Management

EDUCATION REQUIRED: Must be a high school graduate or possess a GED

EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

- Three years Telecom OSP Engineering experience or 10 years field experience with copper or fiber construction, splicing and maintenance.
- Must have working knowledge of PC applications and record data bases

EXPERIENCE PREFERRED:

- Training and experience in GIS
- Advanced understanding of telephone industry standards, local telecom practices and procedures, local city state and governmental rules and regulations.
- Understanding of design and implementation of FTTX and PON networks.
