



JOURNEYMAN LINEMAN - HAINES

We have a full-time opening for a **Journeyman Lineman** at our **Haines, Alaska** location. Our successful candidate will be a self-starter, highly motivated, flexible, detail-oriented, willing to follow directions, willing to travel and must be safety conscious who adheres to and helps expand a safety culture. They will possess excellent team and interpersonal skills, and the ability to work with minimum supervision.

Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Must be able to construct, maintain and repair distribution and transmission circuits.
- Must be able to safely troubleshoot problems with electrical components (Voltages from 120 - 34,500).
- Must participate in an on-call rotation schedule.
- Must be able to respond within 20 minutes to emergency outages, and trouble calls during off-working hours.
- Must live or relocate within 20 minutes of our Haines Operations Facility.
- Must be able to inspect, maintain, and operate all motor & commercial vehicles safely in accordance with all applicable laws.
- Must carry out the directives set out by the Line Operations superintendent and/or Line Foreman including but not limited to:
 - Construction of line extensions
 - Construction of new services
 - Maintenance and repair of power line hardware and substation equipment
 - Installation of transformers
 - Troubleshoot, repair and maintain overhead and underground transmission and distribution systems
 - Stake out completed jobs for GIS
- Must be able to install, remove and read single and three phase electrical meters.
- Must be proficient in the installation of 3 phase transformers.
- Must be able to properly size fuses and transformers.
- Must be able to learn how to develop service and line extension estimates.
- Must be able to hot stick.
- Be willing to operate remote power generation plants.
- Be willing to travel to various locations in Alaska to perform required duties.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education Required

- Must have H.S. Diploma or GED.
- Completion of an accredited 4-year Lineman Apprenticeship Program.
- Hold a current certificate of fitness in the State of Alaska or be able to acquire one within 6 months.

Experience Preferred

- 2 years' experience in power line construction and maintenance as a Journeyman Lineman.

Certificates, Licenses, Registrations

ADL, Class A CDL, First Aid Card, CPR Card, Flagging Certificate, Pole Top & Bucket Rescue Training, rubber gloving Training, transformer training and hot stick training are all required.

Physical Requirements of the Job:

- Must be able to lift 70 pounds regularly and safely.
- Must be able to safely climb poles and work at heights up to 80 feet.
- Must be able to lift, carry, pull, and push items that can weigh as much as 100 pounds
- The job duties of the Lineman require sustained, awkward positions/postures including bending and twisting at the waist and neck, reaching forward, to the side, across the body and overhead.
- Additional requirements of the Lineman position include forceful grip and pinch; manipulation of small objects; balancing on one or both legs during dynamic activities; manipulation of large objects during activities requiring balance and sustained awkward postures.

Starting hourly rate is \$49.44 and is DOE.
