Required (Minimum Necessary) Qualifications (applies to both this section and KSAO's)

- High School Diploma or GED
- Full be able to see full spectrum of color
- Must be able to safely lift to 60 pounds
- Must have a valid driver's license and the ability to be insured by AP&T
- Must possess basic computer skills
- Must be willing and able to travel to other AP&T properties
- Must be able to work in adverse weather conditions

Knowledge, Skills, Abilities, and Other Characteristics

- Excellent organizational and time management skills with the ability to prioritize, multi-task, and confidentially process and maintain data with accuracy with minimal oversight.
- Excellent interpersonal skills to work effectively and cooperatively with all levels of management, staff, customers, and vendors.
- Ability to multi-task and be proactive in a fast-paced environment with frequently changing priorities, deadlines, and workloads.
- Strong professional customer service skills, including active listening, prompt service and follow-up.
- Strong organization skills and exceptional attention to detail.
- Strong decision analysis, problem-solving skills, and critical thinking; ability to draw conclusions and justify decisions.

- Previous right of way clearing and / or tree-trimming experience

NECESSARY PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Employee must maintain a constant state of mental alertness at all times. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Essential and marginal functions may require maintaining physical condition necessary for bending, stooping, sitting, walking, standing and climbing for prolonged periods of time. The employee is regularly required to hear, talk, sit and use hands and fingers to operate a keyboard, mouse and phone. Outdoor work is mostly performed in a bucket truck, climbing poles or standing / crouching. The employee will be required to reach with hands and arms and lift, handle, or move objects weighing up to 60 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include the ability to see the full spectrum of color, close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, and the ability to adjust vision. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. Local and distant travel via light duty truck, bucket truck, ferry, ATV, small aircraft, helicopter, or commercial airplane may be required to support departmental or organizational functions and objectives.
