Heat Pump Incentive Program Guidelines

Alaska Power & Telephone Company is expanding its commitment to clean energy and economic development in rural Alaska by providing an incentive program for electric air and ground source heat pumps. (ASHPs and GSHPs).

December, 2021 update: We are excited to announce that Sealaska Corporation is generously providing an additional \$500 in matching funds for Sealaska shareholders installing heat pumps (for systems installed beginning November 30th, 2021) in AP&T's service areas in southeast Alaska!

Eligibility

1. Applies to systems installed after March 1st, 2021. AP&T will request documentation verifying the date of installation.
2. Only applies to communities where AP&T's regulated power subsidiary, Alaska Power Company (APC), provides service and must actively be providing service to the legal address.
3. AP&T will limit incentives to one per customer, per legal address.
4. The incentive is available equally to all customer types (residential, consumer, etc.) and entity types (individual, family, non-profit, business, tribe, local government, etc.)
5. In a landlord-tenant situation the purchaser of the heat pump will receive the incentive payment, unless otherwise negotiated between the parties. The applicant must list the current account number tied to the legal address. Property ownership may be verified in these situations. Contact incentives@aptalaska.com with any questions.

Technical Requirements

1. Must be an air-source or a ground-source heat pump.
2. Must be a new system (not used or salvaged).

Payment Details

1. AP&T will provide a payment* equal to the lesser of \$500 or the cost of the heat pump (including installation) to the customer after AP&T personnel have verified the system is present and operational.
2. Prior to payment, AP&T personnel must verify the system is present and operational - timing will be dependent on personnel availability in your area.
3. Funds will be made available on a first-come, first-served basis based on the order in which applications are received by AP&T. The time at which applications are received at the email address incentives@aptalaska.com is considered controlling.
4. Does not apply retroactively to heat pumps installed, purchased, or under contract prior to March 1st, 2021.
5. AP&T reserves the right to cancel or modify this program at any time.

To apply for the incentive, please request an application form from your local AP&T customer service representative.
