They will possess excellent team and interpersonal skills, and the ability to work with minimal supervision. This position has remote and/or in office availability.

Required Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Undergraduate degree BS in Business Administration or pertinent Computer/Engineering discipline
- Experience or knowledge related to broadband service provision
- Minimum 5 years of broadband sales in telecommunication environment
- Excellent analytical and troubleshooting skills, excellent ability to present solutions to customers, capable of reviewing and submitting financial data.
- Ability to manage, organize projects and handle multiple objectives at once
- Ability to understand AP&T's network and propose a variety of solutions to carrier and business customers
- Ability to analyze new technologies and estimate the impact on broadband operations
- Experience working directly with users and technical support personnel
- Must have firm verbal and written communication skills and familiarity with network documentation

Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Point of contact for regulated and non-regulated telecommunications sales opportunities for local service including but not limited to space and power, Ethernet, T1 and Hi-Cap Internet services
- Educate and propose innovative solutions to carriers that utilize AP&T's capability to serve customers within its service areas.
- Point of contact for vendors and consultants related to non-regulated sales
- E-Rate, Distance Learning and Telemedicine Sales point of contact
- Track, review and forecast carrier sales on a monthly basis
- Review broadband service offering and identify changes in quantity, quality, and price
- Act as a resource for local, AECA and NECA tariffs related to Broadband
- Assist with the development of new broadband service offerings and coordinate modifications
- Investigate and resolve circuit and service complaint issues generated by customers, technicians, and administrative staff
- Review and evaluate order processes and procedures to find improvements
- Train and support CSR staff related to Broadband services
- Review bills and budgets for outside Broadband and outsourced services
- Travel to remote sites as required
- Performs other work-related duties as assigned

Required Physical requirements of the position:

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

- Employee must maintain a constant state of

mental alertness at all times. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- Some modest local and distant travel via automobile or airplane may be required to support departmental or organizational functions or objectives.
