

Fiber Installation Technician-FTTX (Fiber to the home/business) in Alaska or the Pacific Northwest

These services may include underground drop installations, overhead drop installations, terminal splicing and premise installations. Applicant must be able and willing to adapt to the area's needs, be self-motivated, and comfortable interacting with customers and technology daily. They must be safety oriented and able to work independently with little direction. They must possess excellent interpersonal skills. This will be a 2 weeks on/2 weeks off type of position with travel and housing paid for by AP&T.

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

This will be a part time/seasonal position starting on Prince of Wales Island, Alaska. This position may travel to various locations across the State as needed. This could be 2 weeks on, 2-week of type position with travel and housing provided by AP&T. The primary function of this position will be placing drops to homes and performing the in-home installation to provide high-speed broadband customers

JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide excellent communication with customers regarding bringing fiber to their home
- Install overhead and buried fiber drops
- Splice drops into terminals and in connectors at home.
- Perform in-home installations for Fiber to the Home service
 - Install Inside Fiber
 - Install ONT with power supply
 - o Install Wi-Fi router
 - Document installation with pictures and upload using AP&T software and devices
- Inspects connected devices for proper working conditions.
- Educates customers on the use of all installed or repaired products and services.
- Perform all work to AP&T's standards

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- 5+ Years on the job training in the field of telephony installation, repair, and fiber optic splicing
- High School Diploma or GED
- Driver's License, First Aid, CPR, Flagging Certification, Tower Rescue training, bucket rescue training
- Must have own climbing gear
- Must have own hand tools

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Passport or the ability to obtain one
- CDL

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS:

- Basic knowledge of networking, computer skills, key system installation and troubleshooting
- Valid Alaska driver's license and the ability to be insured by AP&T
- First Aid Card, CPR Card, Flagging Certificate
- Excellent customer service skills
- Willingness to travel to other AP&T exchanges and remote locations
- Ability to pass pre-employment background check and drug test

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be able to safely lift up to 70lbs on a regular basis
- Must be able to see a full spectrum of color
- Position requires frequent walking, standing, sitting, lifting, carrying, pushing, pulling, climbing, crawling, speaking, hearing, seeing, depth perception, color vision, stooping, kneeling, crouching, balancing, and reaching/working overhead.
- This position requires work inside and outside in conditions inherent to an industrial environment.
- The position requires wearing PPE and you must refrain from wearing loose clothing.
- Willingness to work in adverse weather conditions.
- Must be capable to working at heights of 60'
- Must be able to climb poles and ladders.
- Must be capable of working out of a bucket truck.
- Overtime may be required.
